



### Common Assessment Timeline

Summer 2004	<p>WMISD used a RUS Grant to purchase Assessment Connection, a question bank from Scantron, that includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Over 800 skills &amp; tutorials</li> <li>▪ Over 12,000 <i>valid &amp; reliable</i> questions for quizzes and tests</li> <li>▪ Extensive content in Reading, Math and Language Arts for grades 2 through 12</li> </ul>
Fall 2004	eLearning review team with representatives from each district recommends using Class Server for Annual Assessments.
Fall 2004	All local districts agree to administer the Annual Common Assessments in the spring.
04-05	Scantron Questions are used to develop Annual Assessments for Math and ELA for grade levels 3-8
Spring 2005	The first ISD-Wide Annual Assessments are administered. District results have a favorable correlation with MEAP results.
Spring 2005	Curriculum Taskforce & Superintendents recommend development of Quarterly Common Assessments & Curriculum Taskforce sets testing procedures
Summer 2005	Scantron and other question banks (Released MEAP, MMLA, etc) are used to create Quarterly Common Assessments for Math and ELA for grade levels 3-8
Fall 2005	The first Quarterly Common Assessments are administered
05 -06	Curriculum Taskforce reviews testing procedures and formal review process is developed
Summer 06	Math Summit review GLCE. Pacing and uses a question jury process to adjust Common Assessments for Math grade 5-8
